Arise Africa Babies' Home-Bukaleba

We are forever grateful for your prayers, love, financial support and His abundant provision towards His work in our Babies Home that enables us to provide love, care, safe shelter, food, medication, and education, social, spiritual and physical

needs of our 64 (sixty four) vulnerable children of which 20 (twenty) are staying at babies home while the 44 (forty four) were reintegrated back to their close relatives/guardians. This month we present to you Aleka Edwin one of the triplet, he came to our Babies Home on the 16th day of May, 2012, the triplets were estimated to be one day old. After the three kids were born, their father developed a gangrene (wet) on the left leg and was amputated. The right leg was swollen and under pre-operative management by the hospital.

The mother to the triplets suffered stigmatization from her family and community.



She could not take care of them and so she abandoned them to get married to another man. The babies were referred to the Probation and social welfare officer, Mayuge District. The Probation and Social Welfare Office then contacted Arise Africa Babies Home and the triplets were granted

Eddie is 10 years old, with a weight of 25kg and a height of 125cm, he is growing into a handsome boy. He has a good relationship with everyone at home, his best friend is Silas.

Eddie is a hardworking boy who loves taking care of the chickens; he makes sure they are out in the morning and inside by the evening.

Age range 0-2years



In this stage of child growth and development (early childhood) we have 4 (four) children; 3 girls and 1 boy who are undergoing a tremendous growth through physical, language, intellectual and cognitive development, among them include; Mary, Isaac, Selina and Kisakye. ***(A photo showing kids between the ages of 0-2 years).***

Age 3-6 years



These include Enock, Natalia, Tonny, Elise, Caleb, Yonah. Our children under this age group are all attending school; in baby class.

Age 7-12 year

Under this age group we have Aisha, Sheila, Mary, Marvin, Eddie, Jonathan, Elijah, Benjamin, Silas, Eva. They all attend school and have great interest in studying.

Socially, there is a good relationship between all the kids. They show love and care for each other.

We also thank God that few cases of malaria have been reported amongst our Babies Home staff and children during the month of March.

We currently have 30 birds; 11 big ones and 19 chicks. Our plan is to expand our chicken project by 1000 local breed chicken, which will enable us to enjoy eggs daily and meat to sustain us on festive days.

It has been a long way since academic term one began but we are grateful that the Lord is leading us all the way.

Arise Africa Christian nursery and primary school and Arise Africa Christian Primary School of the Deaf

Arise Africa Christian primary school is composed of a nursery school, primary school and school of the deaf children.

Learning

This is the centre of the school whereby the major focus is based.



The learners have been studying despite of a few challenges like teachers not attending school regularly due to delay of their salaries. This has affected the learning of the pupils. However, the

Feeding

Our pupils have been feeding well and we are about to close the term with no much trouble about feeding.

The Staff

We have nine teachers and three support staff doing their best to teach and care for our children. We request for additional support to enable us pay our teachers better.

Health of Children

Basically, our pupils are in good health conditions now. At the beginning of this term the pupils were sickly but after treatment they have now improved and are good.

School Fees Payment

For the case of the pupils paying school fees, the parents are poorly paying fees because they claim that they are not doing well financially. We hope the situation will improve next term.

Examinations

The pupils started their exams on 4th April, 2022 and they are going on well. Term one will end this week on 8th April 2022.

Arise Africa Christian Secondary School

We thank God for the way he is leading us through this term one.

Academics:

We started the term with very few teachers. As time went by, we employed more teachers for the different subjects in both Ordinary level and high school. We now have eighteen teachers. Our staffs have effectively done their job amidst many challenges.

Our student population is still low because most students were affected by covid-19 and lockdowns. Many have got married, others just gave up on school and others simply do not have money to pay school fees. We have total enrollment of 94 students in the whole school. We hope to improve next term.



Our students started internal exams on 28th/April and they will be getting their holidays on 8th/April/2022.

Games and sports:

Our school participated in girls' netball games between 11th and 13th March 2022. On the first league of the game our girls' team won. They proceeded to district games where they qualified to go to the regional games.

We therefore invite you to be a part of our Children's center through;

ii) Giving towards the following;

1. Three laptops for the Babies Home Managers and the nurse to be able to do their work well.
2. Repair of our baby's home van and buy new tyres at **\$1145**
3. Sponsoring a child at babies' home, Nursery, Primary and Secondary schools at thirty five dollars (**\$35**) per month.
4. Children clothing and shoes at **\$600**.
5. Medications for the Children monthly budget of **\$100**
6. Baby's home Sustainability projects growing of beans, corn and vegetables at **\$200**
7. Two thousand five hundred dollars (**\$2,500**) to repair and make better solar power at the babies' home, primary school and secondary school.
8. Building a classroom block for the deaf **\$28,905**

9. Thirty thousand forty dollars (**\$30,040**) to build a foster home for children who will not be adopted and have no homes to return to and have outgrown babies Home care range of below 6 years.
10. Construction of 3 classrooms; we plan to transfer the nursery school from babies' home perimeter to the primary school. Our estimated budget is about Nineteen thousand five hundred dollars (**\$19,500**) to achieve three classrooms.
11. Pray for the LORD'S provision towards budgets of restocking of 30 computers at the cost of Two hundred dollars (**\$200**) per computer at secondary school computer laboratory.
12. Pray for our ministry partners; I love orphans, Ten Eighteen Uganda, World Reach Partnerships and our AAI Family all over the world.
