ARISE AFRICA CHILDREN'S CENTER-BUKALEBA

Arise Africa Children's center is comprised of a Babies home, Nursery, Primary and Secondary schools. We are grateful that schools are now open after almost two years of lockdown. Our children can now study. Please pray that all will go well.



Our goal for the children's center is to see each of our children grow into a health child, develop a personal relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ, excel morally, academically and become a holistic citizen who will positively contribute towards building of the kingdom of our heavenly Father, our country Uganda and the rest of the world.

Arise Africa Babies' Home-Bukaleba

Arise Africa Bukaleba Babies Home is about 12 years old since we began in 2010.

As of today, God has entrusted us with a total of 64 (sixty four) children of which 20 (twenty) are staying at babies home while the 44 (forty four) were reintegrated back to their close relatives/guardians.

Thank you for praying, giving and financially supporting our children; which enables us to provide love, care, safe shelter, food, medication, and education, social, spiritual and physical needs of our vulnerable children. We continue to ask for your prayers that our children will grow into knowing, loving and serving God in Uganda and the rest of the World.



This month we present to you Namususwa Eve, one of the triplet, she was brought to our Babies Home on 16th day of May, 2012.

After the three kids were born, their father developed a gangrene (wet) on the left leg and was amputated. The right

leg was swollen and under pre-operative management by the hospital.

The mother to the triplets suffered stigmatization from her family and community. She could not take care of them and so she abandoned them to get married to another man. The babies were referred to the Probation and

social welfare officer, Mayuge District. That the Probation and Social Welfare Office contacted Arise Africa Babies Home and the triplets were granted placement.

Eva is 10 years old, with a weight of 29kg and a height of 132 cm, Eva has grown into a big girl.

Eva is in primary three, she has much interest in school. She is a reserved girl and very jolly. Eva has a good relationship with everyone and has learnt the rule of sharing with others

Eva is also an active girl; she participates in class, in structural plays and in church.

Academics:

We are happy that on 10th of January, the government officially opened schools for the children, 16 of our kids are at school while the 4 of them are still young however they are attending home schooling.

Health

Children's health

The cases of malaria have been less in the month of January, unlike flu and cough which has been rampant in some of the kids otherwise most of the kids are healthy and strong.

Special cases

a) ART Clinic

Kabulu Moses is not doing well due to poor feeding at his guardian's home yet he takes strong medicine daily. He requests that we consider providing him with food monthly in order to help him improve on his health. He requested for the following food items; **Sugar (4kg) = 12000/=**, **Eggs (1 tray) = 12000/=**, **Millet flour (4kg) = 12000/=**

Total monthly budget = 36000/= \$10

b) Sickle cell case



Faima is doing well, we thank God that she has not got any serious attack in both the month of October and November. Thanks to the director who has delivered her medicine on time when called upon, she is healthy and strong. We are grateful to God for providing **79,000/= \$22** every month to buy her medicines.

We thank God that the schools finally opened on 10th January, 2022 after almost two years closure the Government of Uganda due to Covid-19.

The schools have opened with many challenges but the Lord is helping us through each one of them on daily basis.

Arise Africa Christian nursery and primary school

We are grateful for our Primary School. By the end of January, we had 198 pupils and 9 teachers. Many of our children and staff have not yet returned because of financial challenges by their families. We hope that they join us



soon.

Our pupils are catching up on learning little by little.

Due to the good performance in the Primary Leaving National Exams of 2020, more new children have joined our primary school.

Arise Africa Christian School of the Deaf

Arise Africa Christian School of the deaf started in 2020. We have 35 children and two sign language teachers.

Our deaf children started reporting back to school on 10th January, 2022 and by the end of the same week they had fully arrived. They are catching up alphabetical letters, words and can now write well.

We pray that God provides more funding to enlarge the deaf section because there are many vulnerable deaf children in the villages and their families have neglected them.

Arise Africa Christian Secondary School

We were also able to start school on 10th January, Praise God!



By 31st January, 2022 the total enrollment was 91 students, 46 boys and 19 staff.

Despite the lockdown in 2021, all our senior 4 and senior 6 candidates passed their National exams. One of our S.4 Candidates scored 22 aggregates, emerging the 2nd in Mayuge district.

Mobilization for more students is still going on with the help of the head teacher, teachers and our school coordinators to reach out to parents in the villages.

As Arise Africa children's center, we have many more plans to accomplish this year but we know that our efforts can yield nothing without God's support and provision. Alone we can do so little; together we can do so much.

We therefore invite you to be a part of our Children's center through;

- i) Praying**
- ii) Giving towards the following;**

1. Three laptops for the Babies Home Managers and the nurse to be able to do their work well.
2. Repair of our baby's home van and buy new tyres at **\$1145**
3. Sponsoring a child at babies' home, Nursery, Primary and Secondary schools at thirty five dollars (**\$35**) per month.
4. Support for AAI Babies Home two Managers and Nurse at one hundred dollars (**\$100**) per Month.
5. Children clothing and shoes at **\$600.**
6. Medications for the Children monthly budget of **\$100**
7. Baby's home Sustainability projects growing of beans, maize and vegetables at **\$200**

8. Five thousand six hundred seventy-six dollars (**\$2,500**) to repair and make better solar power at the babies' home, primary school and secondary school.

9. Building classroom block for the dear **\$26,000**
10. Sixty thousand forty dollars (**\$30,040**) to build a foster home for children who will not be adopted and have no homes to return to and have outgrown babies Home care range of below 6 years.

11. Construction of 3 classrooms; we plan to transfer the nursery school from babies' home perimeter to the primary school. Our estimated budget is about Fifty thousand dollars (**\$19,500**) to achieve three classrooms.

12. Pray for the LORD'S provision towards budgets of restocking of 30 computers at the cost of Two hundred dollars (**\$200**) per computer at secondary school computer laboratory.

13. Infrastructure improvement at our schools such as windows glass, flooring in class rooms and dining hall, and furniture.
14. Pray for our ministry partners; I love orphans, Ten Eighteen Uganda, World Reach Partnerships and our AAI Family all over the world.

Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen. (Eph 3:20-21)
